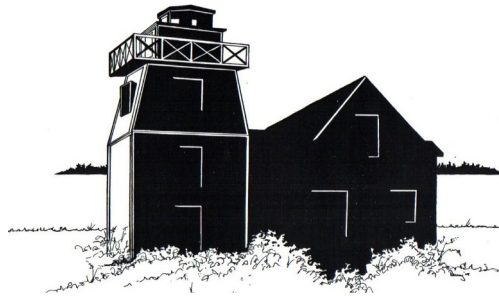
The covered platform is perfect for an outdoor ceremony, and an historic flower garden makes for very memorable pictures.

## The History of Fort Point Museum

The first eyes to fall upon this beautiful land were those of Samuel de Champlain in 1604 while on a mission to colonize for France. His purpose soon took him onward, but he was so impressed with the LaHave area that he was instrumental in it being chosen by King Louis XIII to be the site of the first capital of New France.

In 1632, Isaac de Razilly, French General and Vice-roy, landed at Fort Point on the beautiful LaHave, the largest river in Nova Scotia, and carried out the command of his king. He built a settlement here, with Fort Ste. Marie de Grace on the southern edge of the present day Museum property. It was destroyed by fire in 1654, and its remains carried out to sea.

On the actual site of the museum, a lighthouse was built and was operational for many years, bringing in and taking out ships with cargo from all over the world.

## Interior Accommodations
